Consider why Jesus used this day to perform the miracle of feeding 5000 people.

Is it closely related to the feeding the people of Israel with the Manna in the wilderness?

Do you agree or disagree with this? Why?

#### **Read Matthew 4:23 & Mark 1:38**

Discuss why these ministries are important to the disciples of Christ today?

#### **Read John 6:5.**

Why did Jesus ask Philip this question?

#### **Read John 6:6.**

What does this mean that Jesus asks this only to test him?

#### **Read Deuteronomy 8:3.**

What do we find out about why God sent manna to the Israelites in the wilderness?

#### **Read John 6:35.**

Discuss the purpose of Jesus' living here on earth.

#### **Read John 6:7-9.**

Discuss the difference between Philip and Andrew.

What did you learn from this passage?

#### **Read John 6:10-13**

Discuss what happened in this passage.

This occurrence happened about 2000 years ago. Do you think that these kinds of miracles could happen here in this world today? Why?

#### **Read John 6:32-33 & 6:35.**

Describe what is the purpose of the sign from Jesus.

What did you learn from the bible lesson today?

How will you apply this learning to your own life?
