Facilities

Greyfriars — **Epsom** also has a number of buildings on the site at 10 Gardner Road, Epsom.

Church is our place of worship.

kidzone meets in the hall.

The crèche is situated in a comfortable room at the rear of the church.

Kitchen facilities are in the hall.

Toilets are in the hall foyer.

Parking is available at the road front outside the church. There are no parking restrictions on Sunday. Please note, the Auckland City Council strictly enforces parking restrictions Monday-Saturday. The Diagonal parks are 60 minutes and other parking on the street is 120 minutes.

Greyfriars — **Mt Eden** has a number of buildings on the site. We meet for our services in the **Memorial Hall** (down the driveway at the side of the church). The Church building at 544 Mt Eden Road is temporarily closed while we consider earthquake issues. Our other buildings are situated down the driveway at the side of the church and can be accessed from the car park off Windmill Road.

kidzone meets in McKinney Hall.

The crèche is situated in a room at the left as you enter the hall.

Kitchen facilities are in the Memorial Hall.

Toilets are in the Memorial Hall.

Parking is available adjacent to the hall on Windmill Road.

The Church office is located on the Greyfriars Mt Eden site in the Memorial Hall complex.

We are one church meeting on two sites, Mt Eden and Epsom. Please feel free to attend our services at either location.



We draw on Christ's love for us, the Word of God and a rich Presbyterian heritage to help people know and follow Jesus. We are a church who connects with our community and who seek to follow Jesus in ways which are relevant to our modern lives. We are a compassionate church with a thriving and vibrant spiritual life, who meet in the heart of Auckland. We hope that you will sense the presence of God in our service and that you will feel at home among God's family here.

What to expect at our services

We have two services on Sunday mornings. While each service is slightly different they both aim at uniting us in worship as the family of God. In each service we read the bible and proclaim the good news about Jesus. Here at Greyfriars Eden-Epsom there is a strong faith that is shared across all generations. We welcome visitors and hope that you will make yourself at home with us.

9am (10 Gardener Road, Epsom)

Our church with Kauri timbers, stained glass windows and pipe organ provides a wonderful setting for our warm, friendly and familiar worship services. The focus of the service is strongly on



teaching from the bible in ways relevant to our lives. We worship using a mix of hymns and modern songs, led by a music team with guitars, piano and



violins. Our family friendly service has children participating before they go to kidzone which offers an interesting programme aimed at primary aged children. We also have a crèche for infants. People from all ages and many different cultural groups attend our services

10.30am (Memorial Hall, 544 Mt Eden Road)

Our service is a warm, family-oriented service. This is a place where friendships form as we worship God explore the bible together. We use a mix of contemporary music in our worship, uniting people of different generations and cultures. There is a family learning time before the children leave for their own programme which is called kidzone. Kidzone is a place for fun, friendship

and bible teaching that is age appropriate. The parents' room, for those with crèche aged children, is situated on the left as you enter the hall. Parents may wish to accompany the children to kidzone to help them settle in. You can be confident your children will be welcomed and cared for.



Morning tea is served following both services - Please join us and be our guests for free tea and coffee. Take this opportunity to introduce yourself to us and get to know us better.



Café Service – On the first Sunday of the month we have a café service at 10.30am in the church hall. This is an informal service with opportunity to sit around a table with others enjoying good coffee and a guest speaker.
