Consider yourself at home as we worship together!

It is good to have you with us today as we meet to worship God. Whether you are a visitor to our city or looking for a church home we extend a warm welcome to you.

Greyfriars Eden – Epsom

We are one church meeting on two sites, Epsom and Mt Eden. We draw on Christ's love for us, the Word of God and a rich Presbyterian heritage **to help people know and follow Jesus**. We are a church who connects with our community and who seek to follow Jesus in ways which are relevant to our modern lives. We are a compassionate church with a thriving and vibrant spiritual life, who meet in the heart of Auckland. We hope that you will sense the presence of God in our service and that you will feel at home among God's family here.

What to expect at our services

We have two services on Sunday morning. While each service is slightly different they all aim at uniting us in worship as the family of God. In each service we read the bible and proclaim the good news about Jesus. Here at Greyfriars Eden-Epsom there is a strong faith that is shared across all generations. We welcome visitors and hope that you will make yourself at home with us.

9am (10 Gardener Road, Epsom) – is a **traditional service** with prayers, hymns and bible readings. We use the pipe organ, piano and other instruments for our music. We draw on the Presbyterian tradition of biblical preaching, seeking to learn more about our faith and put it into practice. There is a crèche, and kidzone children's programme at this service.



10.30am (Memorial Hall, 544 Mt Eden Road) – is a **contemporary family service**. Our music group lead us in worship using modern songs. People of different generations come to this informal service. Again we open God's word and expect to hear God speaking to us through the preaching of His word. We begin this service with the



children present. Then they go to our kidzone for fun, friendship and bible teaching that is appropriate for their age. The parents' room, for those with crèche aged children, is situated on the left as you enter the hall.

Parents may wish to accompany the children to kidzone to help them settle in. **You can be confident your children will be welcomed and cared for.**

Morning tea is served following both services - Please join us and be our guests for free tea and coffee. Take this opportunity to introduce yourself to us. Feel free to ask questions about Greyfriars and to get to know us better.

Café Service – On the first Sunday of the month we have a café service at 10.30am in the church hall. This is an informal service with opportunity to sit around a table with others enjoying good coffee and a guest speaker.



Greyfriars Eden-Epsom is an active church with a living faith and a heart for connecting with the people of our community.

Facilities

Greyfriars – Mt Eden has a number of buildings on the site. We meet for our services in the **Memorial Hall** (down the driveway at the side of the church). The Church building at 544 Mt Eden Road is temporarily closed while we consider earthquake issues. Our other buildings are situated down the driveway at the side of the church and can be accessed from the car park off Windmill Road.

kidzone meets in McKinney Hall.

The crèche is situated in a room at the left as you enter the hall.

Kitchen facilities are in the Memorial Hall.

Toilets are in the Memorial Hall.

The office is located near the ramp entrance of the Memorial Hall.

Parking is available adjacent to the hall on Windmill Road.

Greyfriars – Epsom also has a number of buildings on the site at 10 Gardner Road, Epsom.

kidzone meets in the Hall.

The crèche is situated in the entrance of the church.

Kitchen facilities are in the Hall.

Toilets are in the hall foyer.

Parking is available at the road front outside the church. There are no parking restrictions on Sunday. Please note, the Auckland City Council strictly enforces parking restrictions Monday-Saturday. The Diagonal parks are 60 minutes and other parking on the street is 120 minutes.

The Church office is located on the Greyfriars Mt Eden site in the Memorial Hall complex.

If you are uncertain of where to find our facilities please ask for directions
